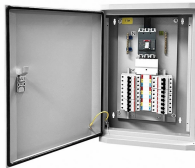

1. Short in time, duration, length, or extent. 2. Succinct; concise: a brief account of the incident. 3. Curt; abrupt: We were upset because he was so brief with us.



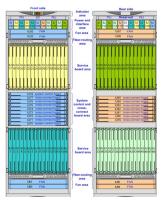
Something that is brief lasts for only a short time. She once made a brief appearance on television. This time their visit is brief.
