

Allowable installation deviations for distribution boxes

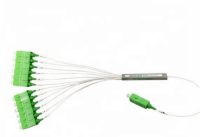


Overview

This article of the National Electrical Code provides the absolute rules for the installation and use of all boxes and conduit bodies. A distribution box is the heart of any electrical system. It takes the incoming power and safely distributes it to different circuits throughout your building. "I've seen too many DIY jobs where people treated. Whether in a wireway or any other box, power distribution blocks installed on the line side of the service equipment shall be listed and marked "suitable for use on the line side of service equipment" or equivalent.

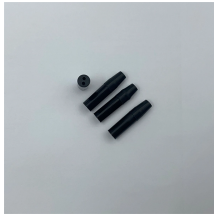
