HP-Aruba Core switch reporting occasional duplicate IPs Our HP/Aruba 5406 core switch is occasionally showing multiple duplicate IP detected messages on 3 of our VLANs.



I suggest you create SVIs on the core switches, establish port-channels between the core switches and create a Layer3 mesh between them advertising routes via IGP.
