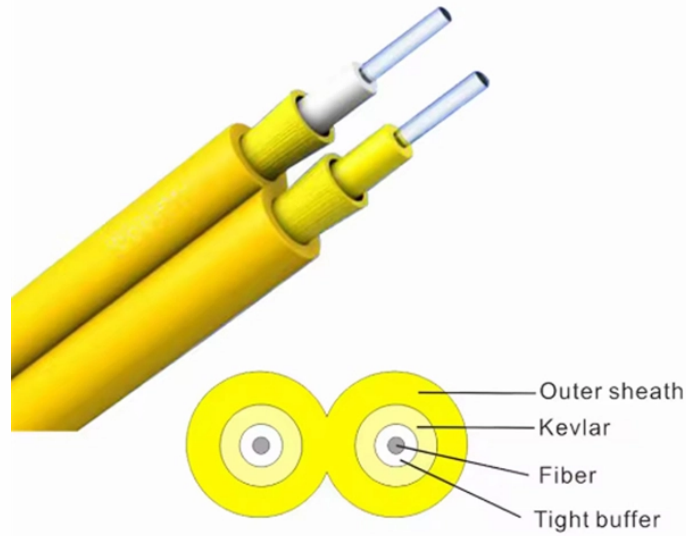


Distribution box tripped during detection



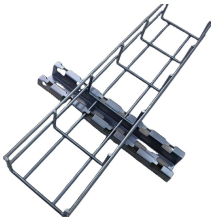
Overview
