For manufacturers exporting to South Korea, the biggest confusion is confirming the correct certification route and corresponding standard numbers. Type 2 products fall under a self-regulatory safety confirmation scheme. EMC compliance is required for the above, where applicable. Submission of. Products subject to KC certification are divided into three types of control systems: Safety Certification (Compulsory) – For high-risk electrical appliances such as refrigerators, washing machines, and power tools.

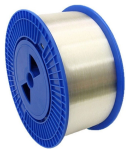
They are not subject to mandatory lab testing in South Korea or factory inspections, but they must be certified by (and registered with) KATS to legally enter the market.
