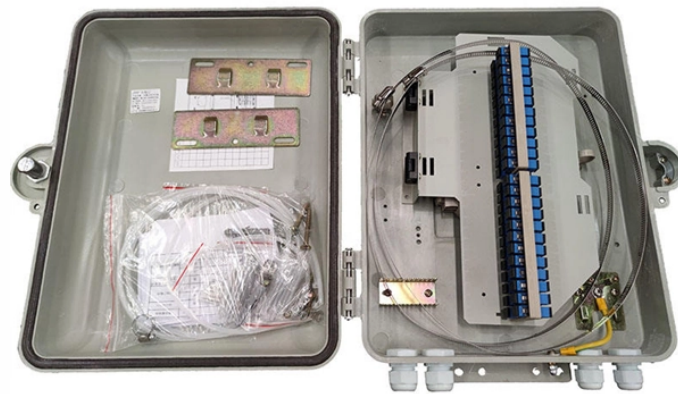


## Fiber Optic Cable Attachment Settlement
