A fiber optic splitter is a passive optical component that divides a single incoming optical signal into two or more outgoing signals, or combines multiple incoming signals into one. For example, it can split a single fiber into two pieces, each with its own connector. Coaxial cables (for RF splitters). 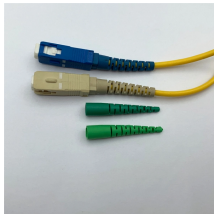
