

Fiji Government-Public Bridge



Overview

The project, aimed at enhancing the resilience of Fiji's transport network, is expected to be completed by 2031. The Fiji Government has secured \$US134. 5 million (approximately \$F307. 7 million) from the Asian Development Bank to replace four key bridges on Viti Levu as part of the Critical Bridges Resilience Project. The funding package, which includes \$US120M (\$F274. For years, villagers crossed a fragile bridge made from corrugated iron to reach the nearby school compound. Known as the Critical Bridges Resilience Project, this initiative is designed to enhance domestic transport connectivity and will be funded. The cabinet has endorsed loan and grant agreements with the Asian

Development Bank to fund the Fiji Critical Bridges Resilience Project, which will strengthen the country's infrastructure.

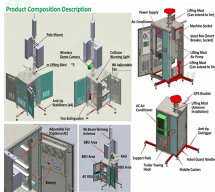
