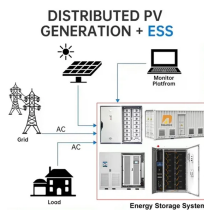

As of 2021, Thailand has made significant progress, with an 85% internet penetration rate and according to Ookla's insight in November 2022, Thailand ranked the fourth in the world for the fastest fixed broadband internet, with the median download speed of 205. 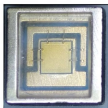
