Overview

Home distribution boxes typically handle single-phase power supplies and contain 6 to 24 circuits. They include standard circuit breakers for lighting, outlets, and major appliances like water heaters and air conditioning units. The minimum size box is the smallest one in the Box Fill Table (shown) that can accommodate that number of conductors. No matter how many ground wires, they only count as one conductor in the box. A wire running through the box counts as one wire. Each wire coming into a splice connector is counted. A distribution box, also known as a distribution board, electrical panel, or breaker box, is an enclosure that houses electrical components responsible for distributing electricity throughout a building.
