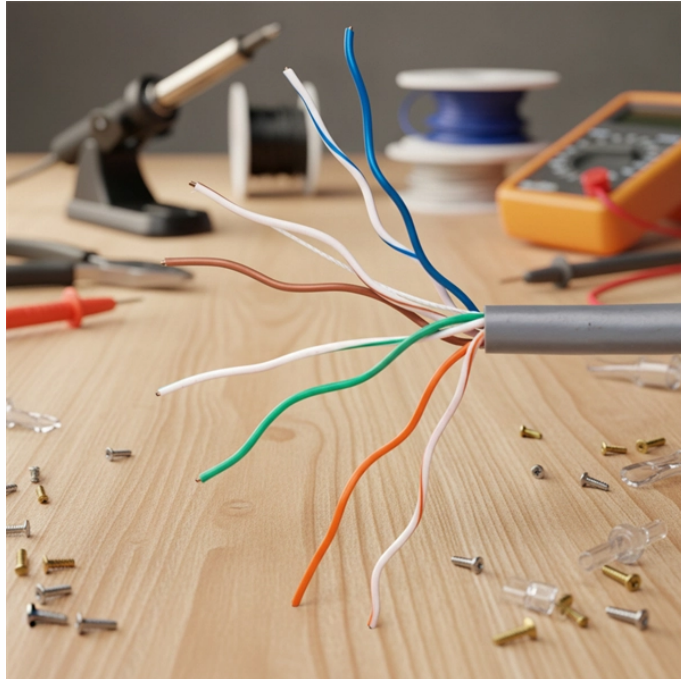


How to affix the three-color labels to the distribution box

Whilst a label isn't specifically required by this Regulation, an easy, clear and professional way to indicate the periodic check would be to place a durable label on or near to the board.



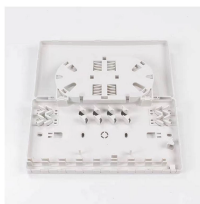
Attach labels close to the connectors in such a way that they remain visible but do not inhibit connections or bundling activities. As much as placing the label is essential, a secure, real ...



Add this to your circuit list. Use the permanent marker plates in the panel or purchase plastic label holders that snap or stick onto the panel. Clearly hand write or print and place a label ...



Once every breaker has been tested and documented, create clean, permanent labels for the panel. Use a marker or label tape to write detailed descriptions for what each breaker powers.



You might feel a little nervous about opening your distribution box, but you can do it safely if you follow some simple steps. Let's walk through what you need to know before you start.
