If your modem is near the splitter, disconnect the coax going into the modem and connect the coax going into the input connection to the splitter (far left) to the modem.



Ensure all of the devices have been powered off. Connect a coax cable from the wall outlet to the splitter. Connect another coax cable from the splitter to the back of device 1. Connect another coax ...



If you absolutely must have an unused connection, whether it's a port on a splitter or a long unused run of cable, you really need to terminate. What you'll need: Terminators. You don't ...
