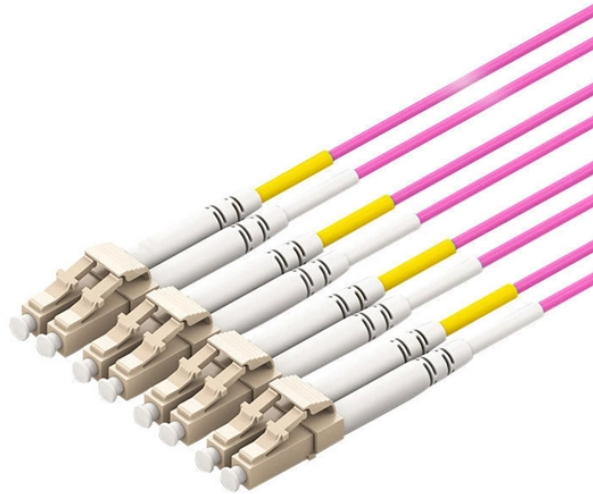


How to lay cables in layers within cable trays

Installation of Cable in Cable Trays involves precise routing on support systems, NEC/IEC compliance, grounding, ampacity derating, bend radius control, segregation of services, fire safety, labeling, and reliable cable management for industrial and commercial facilities. I see many electricians lay cables on a wrong way. A rung spacing of 6 to 9 inches (150 to 230 mm) is preferable when.
