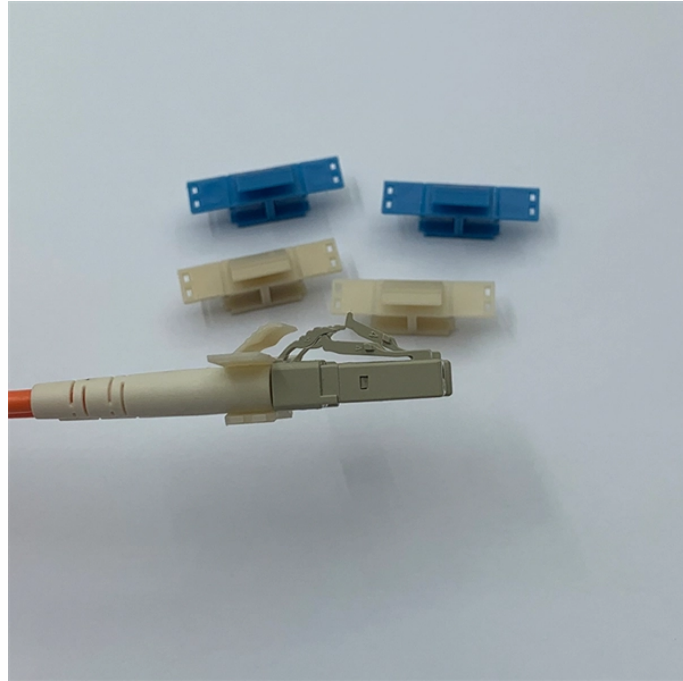


How to make wiring in a large electrical distribution box look neat

A neat, well-organized subpanel bundles wires to conserve space and improve access. Label short sheathing sections (slugs) to indicate which circuits wires serve. Ideally, wire groups are installed in layers and wires are bent at.
