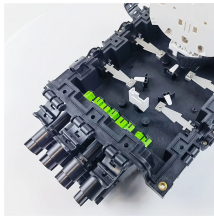

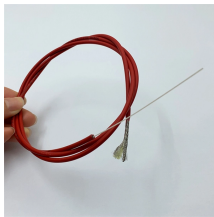
Duct fiber optic cable refers to a specific type of optical cable specifically designed for wiring through pre laid ducts (duct materials can be selected based on geographical location, such as concrete, asbestos cement, steel pipes, plastic pipes, etc). The cable installation method is selected based on site conditions and availability of machinery & resources. Table 1 shows a

comparison between the two installation methods.

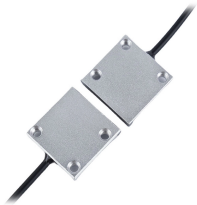
Fiber optic cables are blown into ducts/microducts creating communication infrastructure. The duct is made of high-density polyethylene which protects the cable from mechanical damages and moisture. ...



Testing has shown that micro-duct cables can buckle in the machine if the leak-of valve is not properly set for the cable and duct configuration during the crash test, as shown in the pictures to the right.
