Position the outer rim of a single-gang or double-gang tiger-grip box at the face of the back wall inside a cabinet or at the outer face of the cabinet's side at the desired location. Learn how to install a distribution box safely and correctly. Covers wiring, placement, standards, and expert tips for a compliant setup. Wherever you may want to place your circuit box, you must follow the electrical panel mounting requirements dictated by the NEC (National Electrical Code). For the sake of brevity, The National Electrical Code outlines that a breaker box must be installed in an area that provides clearance around. Electrical panel boxes, aka breaker boxes, can be on a wall in an out-of-the-way area of your home. Current National Electrical Codes (NEC) allow none of these locations. Electrical panels. 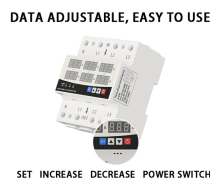

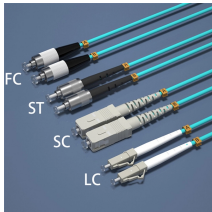

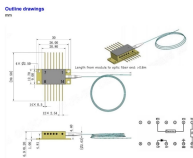
If you're determined to install the electrical panel in the kitchen, your best option is to keep it inside a cabinet on the wall. Cabinets can protect the panel without limiting the working space.
