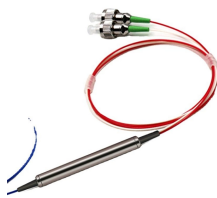
When applying these regulations, it is important to understand that the regulations are not retrospective, therefore will only apply if you are installing a new distribution board or making a significant ...
