

The house does not have an electrical distribution box



Overview

The short answer is yes and no. Every compliant home has a main electrical control point. These switches flip off when the current gets too high. About 90% of homes today use this standard system., solar panels) and distributes it to various circuits throughout the house. The builders never ran any electric into the garage so I'm in the process of running it myself (the breaker is in the garage so it should be pretty easy). I'm getting ready to wire it into the breaker box, but I noticed that there is no main. The main breaker disconnect is a larger-amp circuit breaker that shuts off all power to electrical panels and subpanels in a building.

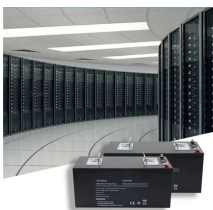
