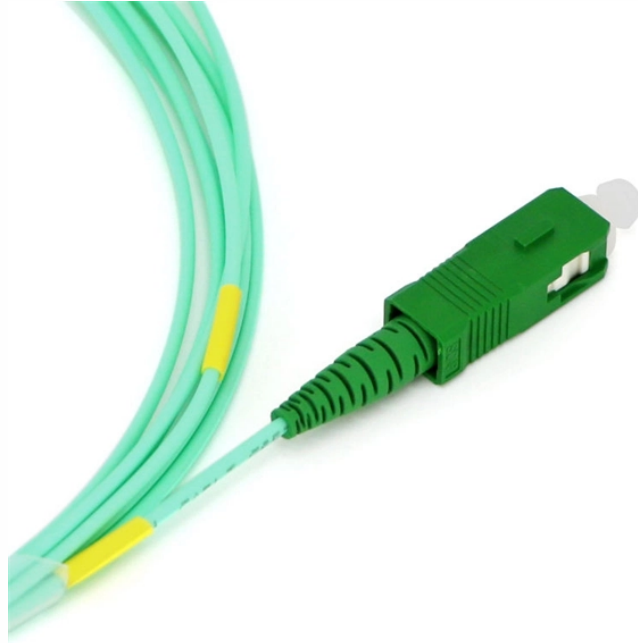

An overcurrent circuit breaker or fuse rated for rated 1pu FLA will not trip. However, a properly set motor unbalanced current relay can easily detect and clear this condition. In summary, when the power goes out but the circuit breaker has not tripped and you are at a loss for what to do, following these simple steps can help you to successfully address the problem.



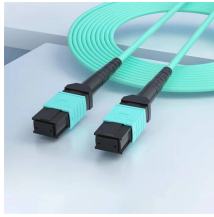
