The cable cost was around T\$36 million and was financed through grants from the World Bank Group and the Asian Development Bank. It is 827 kilometres (514 mi) long and was activated in 2013. It has cable landing points at Sopo, a suburb of Nuku'alofa in Tonga, and Suva, Fiji. 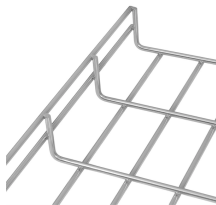
