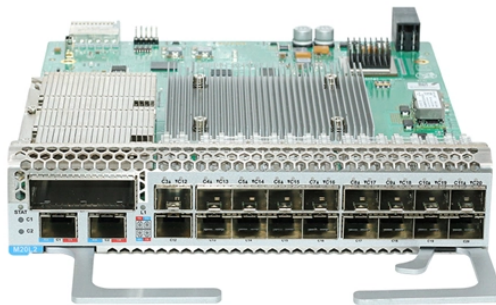


Wall opening for installing distribution box



Overview

The cutout is best achieved using a job saw or keyhole saw, carefully following the traced lines to create a snug opening. Once the hole is cut, the electrical cable must be fed through the opening, leaving six to eight inches of wire extending out for connection to the device. If it's done poorly, you risk short circuits, fire hazards, or system failure. Done right, it ensures. Before starting the installation, finding a proper place for putting the distribution box is crucial, because it largely decides the safety and convenience of maintenance. Old work boxes, also known as remodel boxes, are specifically designed for installation and use of boxes. The LINE grounding wire is attached to the 10/32 screw in the back.
