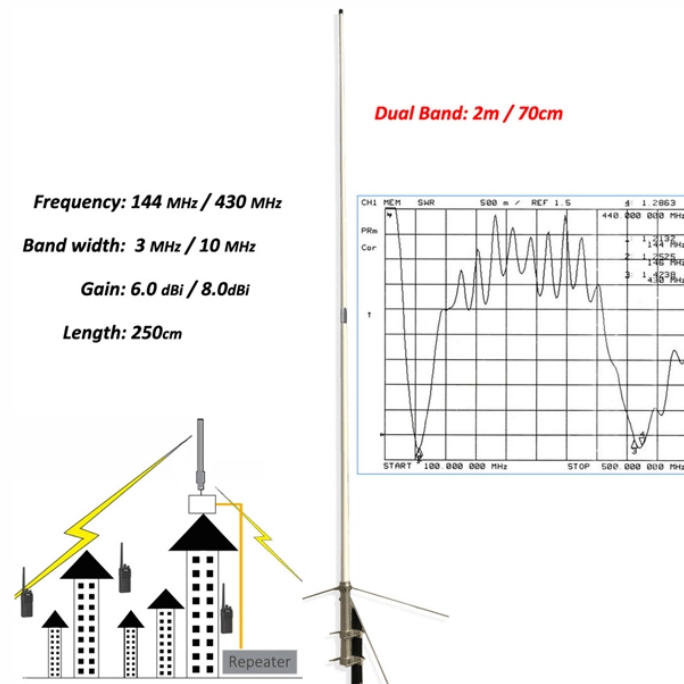

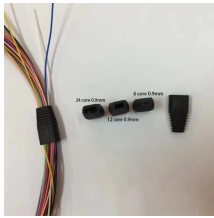


Overview

The frequency detected by an optical power meter typically refers to the frequency of a modulated test tone used for fiber identification and continuity testing, not a property of the meter itself. These test tones are commonly 270 Hz, 1 kHz, or 2 kHz. 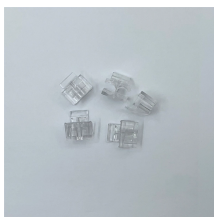
