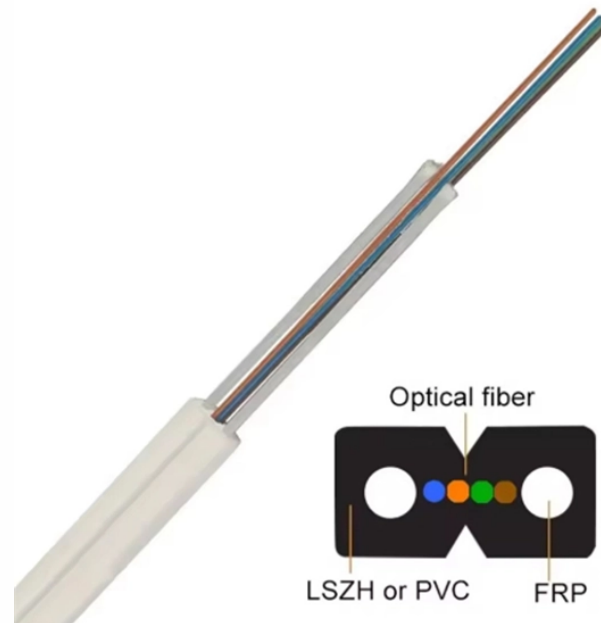


What is a 2 8 beam splitter

In a Michelson interferometer, the beam splitter divides a single beam into two paths, sends them to mirrors, and then recombines them to create an interference pattern. Analyzing this pattern allows engineers to detect small changes in distance or variations in the optical path. Beamsplitters are optical components used to split incident light at a designated ratio into two separate beams. Beamsplitters are often classified according to their construction: cube or plate. 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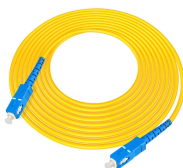
