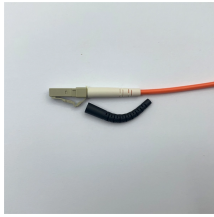

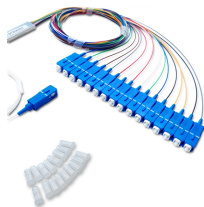
A junction box, often called a J-box or electrical box, is a protective enclosure built to protect electrical connections and wiring within. These boxes serve as a housing for electrical circuits ...
