

Where is the reset button on the passive fiber optic router in Afghanistan



Overview

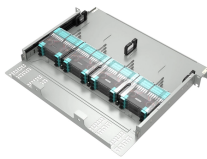
Locate the reset button on the back or side of the router. It is usually a small hole with a reset symbol. Power off the router: Ensure that the router is powered. Port 1 also supports 24V Passive PoE to power the device. When it's green and steady, everything is fine. ASUS routers have several ways you can perform a factory reset outside using the Reset button.

Locate the recessed reset pinhole on the back or bottom of your router — it's a small hole, not a button you can press with a finger. Insert a pin, straightened paperclip, or SIM card tool.



Once you have held down the reset button, turn the router back on using the power switch. Wait for the indicator lights to stabilize, which may take a few minutes.



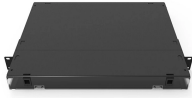
Note: 24V Passive PoE is required to power the device. WARNING: The PoE switch must comply with the power specifications listed in the Specifications section of this Quick Start Guide.



Identify the reset button: Locate the reset button on your fiber internet router. It is usually a small, recessed button that may require a pin or paperclip to press.



Find the reset button on the rear panel of the router. NOTE: In the example below, the router is shown on its side. Use a pen or straightened paper clip to press and hold the reset button for 10 seconds. ...



Make sure the router is powered on and fully loaded up. Locate the Reset button on your router (usually on the back or bottom). Press and hold the Reset button for 10-15 seconds until the ...



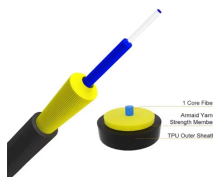
The "reset" button can be found on the back or bottom of the router. **IMPORTANT!** You must be aware that resetting the router will change ALL settings back to default settings, including your network ...

On nearly every router and mesh system I've tested, all you do is insert a straightened paper clip into the Reset hole and push down on a button until the LEDs flicker. That's it. Easy peasy ...



The reset button is usually found on the back or bottom of the router, sometimes labeled as "Reset." Due to its design, it may often be recessed into the casing to prevent accidental presses, ...
